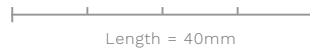

To ensure that the rings are shown in the correct sizes, please check that this print has the correct size. Please print this guide and find a ruler which can measure exactly 40 millimetres:



Find a ring which is exactly the size of the finger you wish to wear the ring on. Choose your size by placing the ring on one of the rings on the sheet below. The inside diameter of the ring should match the diameter of one of the circles.

Use a ruler or a caliper to measure the inside diameter of the ring and find the equivalent diameter of one of the circles. For example, if your ring has an inside diameter of 17.8 mm, this will correspond to size 56. If the diameter falls between two sizes, choose the larger size.

Remember that the size of your fingers will vary according to the surrounding temperature, so measure them at room temperature. In summer your fingers will generally be larger than in winter.

The size of the ring can also vary depending on the ring design and how this will fit your finger. A wide ring may require a larger size and several rings worn on the same finger may also require a larger size to fit comfortably. We recommend you order 1 size larger than you would for just one narrow ring. Also keep in mind that wide knuckles will impact the size of the ring. If you are unsure, you are always welcome to visit our studio and we will sort you out. If you need to make an alteration of the size, we can help you get the perfect fit.
